21. Brief write up/citation on the work done by this person :

Sudhanshu Chaturvedi is a writer, translator and academic who was born and brought up in Uttar Pradesh in an ancestral zamindar family. Sudhanshu Chaturvedi later made Kerala his home state and Malayalam his pet language. Four and half decades down the lane he holds a double doctorate in Hindi and Malayalam and is the author of 160 books spreading in four languages Hindi, Malayalam, Sanskrit and English. Out of these 160 books more than 50 books are in Malayalam.

In the year 1962 a 19 year old post graduate in Sanskrit from a college at Bareilly in Uttar Pradesh went to the then Prime minister of India Pandit Jawharlal Nehru and questioned the wisdom of non implementation of making Hindi the National language. Pandit Nehru was irritated with the youth and he blurted out People from the North want everyone to learn Hindi. But how many of them are willing to take lessons in a south Indian Language. Can you learn a south Indian language and become a writer. The youngster readily accepted the challenge and asked Tell me which language should I learn. Nehru told Malayalam. Soon after this incident the youth joined in Delhi University to study Malayalam.

After completing the studies from Delhi University Sudhanshu reached the state of his dreams Kerala in 1964. The next year he joined as a lecturer in the Hindi Department of the prestigious SreeKeralaVarmaCollege, Trichur and 34 years later when he left that temple of higher education as Principal.

Dr.SudhanshuChaturvedi had even prior to his migration to Kerala many literary works to his credit in Hindi and Sanskrit at the age of twenties. After mastering Malayalam Sudhanshu took a great leap forward to acquaint the people of Hindi area with the richness and beauty of Malayalam literature. He therefore rendered a large number of Malayalam works of prominent authors like Thakazhi'sEnippadikal,Kayar, Uroob'sSundarakalumSundaranmarum, P.Kesavadev's Ayalkar, OdayiNinnu, Basheer's BalyakalaSakhi, Lalithambika Antharjanam's Agnisakshi, Azhikode's Tatwamasi, Mukundan's MayyazhiPuzhayudeTheerangalil, and many more. From Hindi to Malayalam also he has rendered a number of authors works like Amratalal Nagar, Yashpal etc. His most prominent books in Malayalam are Srimad Valmiki Ramayanam in four volumes, Kalidasa Sahitya Sarvaswam and Bhasa Nataka Sarvaswam. For the great contributions of Dr.SudhanshuChaturvedi for which he was given awards like Central Sahitya Akademi Award, Kerala Sahitya Akademi Award, Rangeya Raghav Paryatan Puraskar, Rashtra Bhasha Ratna Rashtriya Samman, Uttar Pradesh Hindi samsthan's Sauhrda Award, Bharatiya Bhasha Parishad Anuvad Sree Award, Vidya Bhushan Award of UP Hindi Sansthan etc.
